

NOTES FOR COMPETITORS

Please Read Carefully!

Welcome to the Timetable documents for the 65th Devizes Junior Eisteddfod being held on Saturday 26th November 2011. As ever, the timetable has been put together in such a way as to ensure that all competitors can get to their classes without clashes. In some instances, the timings are tight so please plan your day carefully and make sure you know where you are going! The classes are held in six venues across the Town Centre: St John's Church (Sanctuary), St Andrew's Church (Sanctuary), Sheep Street Baptist Church (Sanctuary), Sheep Street Hall, Town Hall and Wharf Theatre. A street map is available from the website to download. Car parking can be found at The Wharf, Station Road and in the centre of the town behind the Market place – accessed from New Park Street.

Classes will begin at 0900 promptly in most venues and access to each venue will be from 0845. Please respect other competitors and keep the noise to an absolute minimum when in and around the venues.

Results will be available approximately one hour after the end of the class. Please make sure you check the Section winners list to see whether you are required to play in the evening concert – the expected times of section winner results are listed below for ease of reference – these are approximate and we will endeavour to get them out on time, however, things don't always run smoothly and your patience will be appreciated. We will be unable to make individual calls to competitors – if you are unable to stay to check the results, please make sure you make arrangements with a teacher or friend to relay them to you. If you are unable to play in the concert, please inform Reception as soon as possible so changes can be made to the programme.

Child Protection Policy

The Eisteddfod is run by volunteers recruited from a group of people who have shown an interest in the Eisteddfod and offered to give their time. They indicate what sort of tasks they would prefer to undertake. Each volunteer on duty will wear a badge, and any one of them can be approached at any time in case of a problem; they will attempt to deal with it, or will indicate the responsible person. Children remain the responsibility of their parent/teacher/carers at all times during the event. We will make every effort to ensure their safety and well-being however, we cannot assume any responsibility for your children if and when they need to move between venues, and when they may be waiting between classes. Given the nature of our venues within the centre of the Town it is very important that children are supervised by their parent/carers at all times when moving between venues.

No photography or recording of any kind is permitted at the Eisteddfod, except by official Eisteddfod Photographers (who will wear a badge) or the Press (by arrangement). If any parent or teacher does not wish their child to be photographed then it is their responsibility to ensure they do not take part when photography is happening. This can be done by informing an Eisteddfod volunteer or the MC at the final concert.
